

Q3- Default FTP Folder login with storage quota

Create a default folder for Username or Contact login. This is typically used for systems that do not want to change to a working directory. You can also specify a storage quota of "0 GB" to ensure that files are uploaded only to shares

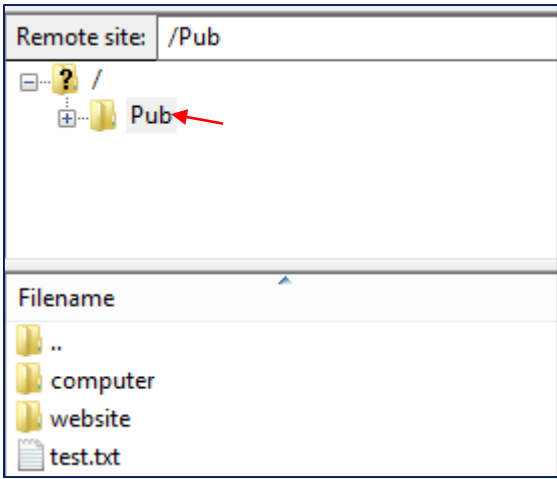
- 1- Select Users tab → Options and the specific user to set the default folder**
 - i. Under Options enter the default folder for login e.g. Pubs. You can specify sub-folders with a / i.e. Pubs/Download
 - ii. To ensure that files are only uploaded to shared folders "Add a storage quota of 0 GB"
 - iii. Click Save

- 2- Login with an FTP Client**
 - i. Login to your Hosted~FTP~ account
 - ii. You will be placed into the "Remote working directory" as set under the Options area.

- 2- Login with a browser**
 - i. Login to your Hosted~FTP~ account (this [link](#) for US and this [link](#) for UK)
 - ii. You will be placed into the "Remote working directory" as set under the Options area.
